This week MSP's have been busy debating the Scottish budget and the government's priorities for the coming three years.

I stayed behind on Thursday after the vote to listen to George Foulkes MSP lead off his debate on how to improve the Organ Donation System. I am considering supporting his proposal and I would like to hear your views – [follow this link to read George's speech](#).

This week I have supported the work of student clubs on campuses to highlight the sustainability of university institutions as well as a motion highlighting the humanitarian crisis in Gaza.

At last I got selected at Question Time to press Scottish Ministers on the issue of housing in multiple occupations (HMOs), which I have been campaigning on for many years. I believe we need to provide a better housing mix in Glasgow Kelvin, to ensure that we have both affordable housing options and a response to the concerns of neighbours living underneath or near a large number of HMOs. I was promised a meeting on the issue and my young assistant, Laura, from Dumbarton Academy who is doing work experience with me was on the case immediately looking for dates for me to meet the Minister.

I also met with the pupil council at Glasgow Gaelic School to discuss improved recreation facilities at the school and my campaign for a community facility for the Anderston area.
