

Welcome to my website, I began the New Year by launching a consultation with constituents on proposals to improve the regulation of property factoring and by lodging a [motion](#) in Parliament highlighting the predicament of many students who suffer hardship as a result of unscrupulous landlords who unfairly withhold deposits at the end of a lease.

Locally there was [good news](#) with the saving of Hyndland Post Office from closure, but, I was bitterly disappointed that Post Office management failed to listen to the case for High Street, Anderston and Broomhill branches.

The Partick Tesco Public Local Inquiry will begin soon and I attended the pre-inquiry meeting in Partick Burgh Hall to make sure the arguments of local people are fairly held. The Christmas holidays saw the first of the taxi marshals and new CCTV, which I successfully campaigned for, finally deployed.

Finally in Parliament I am raising the issue of parents seeking contact orders for access to their children; a pilot project was due to proceed in the Scottish Courts but has been cancelled by the government - I will be making arguing for the promise to be kept.
